Position Description:

The Instructor will be responsible for providing high-quality sailing instruction during the Club's eight-week junior sailing program, and assisting with the Club's junior sailing racing program on an as-needed basis.

MBBC prioritizes a fun and safe learning environment. The Instructor will be responsible for positively representing the Club by creating a welcoming, professional environment for junior sailors, Club members, and parents and guests of junior sailors.

Period of Performance:

- June 21-August 13, 2021: Weekdays, 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Prior to June 21 and after August 13, Part-time (with duties as assigned by the Program Director)
- Additional hours may be required when the Club's junior sailors participate in regattas (at home and away)

Duties & Expectations (include, but are not limited to):

- Provide high-quality sailing and small boat racing instruction, and ensuring that all students are supervised and participating in a safe and professional environment
- Follow US Sailing curriculum or similar curriculum, as directed by the Program Director
- Implement day-to-day instruction lesson plans and race team plans that are appropriate for the weather conditions and participants' skill levels, as directed by the Program Director
- Assist with race coaching at home and away regattas, as needed and requested by the Program Director
- Assist with organizing at least one on-site junior sailing regatta
- Foster a system and culture of rewarding positive behaviors the Club seeks to instill in our junior sailors, including as sportsmanship, seamanship, and safety
- Implement the Club's safety protocols
- Ensure program participants follow the Club's Junior Sailing Code of Conduct
- Work with Program Director to ensure that the program, boats, and instructors are ready prior to the start of the first session of the summer program (before June 21, 2021)
- Participate in weekly planning meetings with the Program Director
- Assist the Program Director in maintaining the Club's boats throughout the season,
- Clean and preparing all boats for winter storage in good condition following the conclusion of the program in August
- Keep all required certificates current

Qualifications:

- Minimum, US Sailing Level 1 instructor certification
- Current Basic First Aid & CPR certification
- Demonstrated sailing instruction experience. Small boat racing experience (skipper or crew) preferred, but not required.
